Concept of the exhibition: The tradition of the Volkstheater in Liechtenstein dates back to around 1920. At that time, many male choirs began to perform folk theater during the carnival season. The only purpose was to entertain the audience - and that has remained so to this day. Demands increased: in 1940 an operetta was staged in Vaduz for the first time, followed by Balzers in 1946. These operettas were the highlights of Liechtenstein's cultural life. Visitors came in droves from all over the region. But the men's choirs were overwhelmed by the constantly growing demands. The operettas had to be placed on a new footing, and for this purpose the operetta societies were founded. Today they are facing new challenges: In order to secure the future of the operettas, it needs the loyalty of the audience, a good anchoring in the village and in the region, the goodwill of the sponsors and the public sector as well as the participation of well-known stars.
