Concept of the exhibition:	On 29 March 1923, Switzerland and Liechtenstein signed a treaty that was a landmark for Liechtenstein; it came into force on 1 January 1924. The customs treaty integrated Liechtenstein into the Swiss economic area and freed it from economic isolation. By entering into the customs treaty, Liechtenstein relinquished part of its sovereignty. It had to adopt all Swiss laws relating to the customs treaty. Only a few years after the treaty came into force, Liechtenstein felt that the anticipated economic improvement had materialised. The Liechtenstein NationalMuseum in Vaduz and the Swiss Customs Museum in Gandria are celebrating the 100th anniversary with a joint exhibition. The exhibition shows the background and history of the customs treaty and illustrates many different aspects of relations between Switzerland and Liechtenstein.
