Concept of the exhibition:	The Principality of Liechtenstein has experienced rapid change in the last 120 years, developing from a poor, largely agricultural society into a rich, highly developed hub of industry and services. This transformation can be observed in the changing appearance of Liechtenstein's towns and villages, many of which are depicted on postcards from the early the 20th century. The exhibition „Liechtenstein then and now – a history of the country told through historical postcards and modern photographs“ in the Liechtenstein PostalMuseum features selected postcards showing Liechtenstein's eleven municipalities, juxtaposed with modern photographs of the same locations. The postcards are drawn from the collection of the Liechtenstein NationalMuseum. The photos were taken starting from late summer 2020 by the Liechtenstein NationalMuseum's photographer, Sven Beham.
