knowledge that recent excavations have

unearthed and it develops, also from a geological

and scientific perspective, the complex

phenomena related to volcanism and bradyseism. Pliny the Elder leads the audience through the exhibition. He lived first-hand the events of those fateful days, in the desperate attempt of saving the inhabitants escaping from the tragic eruption. In the exhibition you see famous original artworks from Pompeii and Herculaneum together with multimedia immersive environments. A project that consolidates the collaboration between the Liechtenstein National Museum and the National Archaeological Museum of Naples which started several years ago and the partnership with the Italian companies of Expona and Contemporanea
