Concept of the exhibi-

tion:

Under the patronage of Her Royal Highness Hereditary Princess Sophie of Liechtenstein, the association Art and Prison e.V. is showing works from its latest art competition "Back to Life". Art can open windows to freedom for people in prison. The images address not only those affected, they also raise the profile of relevant issues amongst "normal" citizens. The artworks visualise life perspectives, beyond the standard habits of seeing according to the theorems of established art criticism. Focusing on the human condition becomes possible in the exchange of perspectives and not in their polarisation. There are many aspects to consider here, especially in times of pandemic and lockdown. Shattered hopes, startling messages, breaking out of confinement, stagnation and loneliness. Not only in prison; for everyone there is an "inside and outside", a before, an in the midst of – and a (better) future. We always gaze back upon ourselves in the pictures, as well as at the stranger and the unknown in us. Personal responsibility cannot be separated from the guilt of others. Pictures from Prison hold up a mirror to society. Art is everywhere and builds bridges.
