The two faces of football

Football is a complex matter, especially today when the game has evidently become something quite different from what it was in the very first editions of the World Cups. In the past, football essentially consisted of players and dark leather balls, hand-stitched and without logos. As we well know, men's football in our day is much more: a mirror of the entire planet, a reflection of both its good and bad sides. Today the game has two faces, like medals. And its other face is women's football. This is a world with fewer resources and less media attention, but perhaps for this reason it is closer to the original spirit of the game. It is an incredibly fascinating sport, as is appreciated by fans who are becoming more numerous each year.
